

Fall Valor Update

Last newsletter, I wrote about making a fall Valor application to help with kochia control. Some growers applied Valor after the soil temps got below 50°F and had some really good luck. Here is a picture that shows a distinct line to where Valor got applied and where it did not. This fall, I would encourage anyone having trouble killing problem weeds such as kochia to give fall Valor a try. We can take care of lining up an airplane if someone doesn't want to or isn't able to apply it themselves. Just let us know which fields and we will get them booked!





Corn Rootworm Update

Andrew Kappes, our territory Pioneer field agronomist, has sticky traps set out all over the area trapping corn rootworm beetles. Corn rootworm beetle populations have continued to grow each year (even on corn-soybean rotations). This information will help make better-informed decisions for the following years as to what traits (such as Qrome or Vorceed) and/or which insecticides might be needed in certain fields or situations going forward. Locally, we have had averages of 27 per trap up to 48 per trap in certain weeks. High rootworm pressure is over 50 beetles/trap. To the left is a picture of one of the sticky traps with the beetles sticking to it.

14A12E

We have gotten a small taste of 14A12E beans this year and they sure look like they will be a good fit for our area. As we continue to expand and grow our soybean lineup, we have to look at what this bean does that other beans in its maturity range do not: iron deficiency chlorosis. These 14A12E beans have a very good IDC score, whereas the other beans just don't hold up as well. It appears that it's going to be a taller and bushier plant, which will be really nice for the 30" rows. It also has an acceptable white



mold score. Our soybean lineup is constantly changing and we want to make sure we are bringing the best possible options forward. We are happy to see more A-Series beans making their way into our area maturity range. We feel they truly are the best beans on the market.

97299AM/Q

With so many advancements in corn hybrids the last 5 years, how do you highlight just one product? Is it by yield? Is it by certain soil types it prefers? Is it a disease package? Is it by stalks and roots? The answer is yes to all. When you find a product like the 97299 family, we definitely need to get the word out there. This new hybrid is a 97-day, but has a 94-day silk which can help the guys that don't push maturity that high. It is superior to everything on drought tolerance, and it has very good root & stalk strength. This is a hybrid that can go on your tough ground, but will run away on the good ground. It comes in AM and Qrome, which means double and triple stack options. It has a very good stress emergence score as well, which helps to feel comfortable going out early with it along with putting it in a corn-on-corn environment. It is a hybrid that will flex well so we can really play with the populations. We are super excited for this hybrid, as well as all of our new 5 digit hybrids. They sure seem to have an extra gear to them and we are looking to see more of them in the future!



With only three components, they will be very easily installed and adjusted. Part of those components will be a replaceable wear clip that will lessen the damage from the mustache, leading to a longer-lasting gauge wheel arm.
